Borrow a Kill A Watt®

Find ways to save money and energy at home

The Thomas Crane Public Library and the Quincy Climate Action Network (Quincy CAN) are teaming up to put money-saving Kill A Watt® meters in the hands of Quincy library patrons—at no charge to you!

A Kill A Watt® meter can tell you how many watts of electric power your appliances are using. It also tells you an appliance's energy use over time in kilowatt hours (kWh), the measure used to calculate your electric bill. Because kilowatt hours add up to dollars, the Kill A Watt® meter can also help you figure out how much each appliance is costing you, a first step toward saving both energy and money.

HOW TO BORROW A KILL A WATT®

Stop by the main library or any branch library to borrow a Kill A Watt® kit. Library card holders can borrow one for two weeks and renew for two weeks more if no one else is waiting for the Kill A Watt® kit.

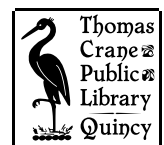
DETAILS
